THE AUTHOR

INTRODUCTION

The following pages were written by Sri Swami Omkar two years ago, during a fast which lasted for forty days.

Swami Omkar is a mystic. I do not now wish to discuss the value and validity of mystic consciousness. But I must point out that Swami Omkar's mysticism is virile and rationalistic, to the extent mysticism could be rationalistic. He does not claim to have had any peculiar visions or weird dreams. He, of course, has realized the unity of the whole world in the one thing Real —the Spirit. He has no attachment of any sort to dogmas and creeds, nor is his love and friendship limited to one country or nation. His is a global view—a view which embraces Man as such. In like way he worships God—not the God revealed in this religion or that but God who is claimed to be revealed in every religion, but who is fully and perfectly revealed in none.

Obviously those who are imprisoned within their own parochial grooves mistake him. The Jews of his days excommunicated Spinoza. And when Hegelian theologians like Troeltsch declared that Christianity is not the absolute religion, critics were not wanting. I am sure followers of other religions also would react in the same way, if they are told that their scriptures too do not contain the last word of wisdom. That is inevitable. If one wants to rally a following and command an influence he must take shelter under a banner, adopt a slogan and then sound the drum, Brave as he is to the core, Swami Omkar refuses to become a slave of anybody or any 'ism'. He stands by himself and that only is Truth for him, which he has discovered or which he has assimilated, He is literally *atmani sthithah* (*established in Atman*). It is for this I admire him and it is this in his admirable personality that has attracted me.

I have been intimate with many religions men both Christian and Hindu. But no where do I find freedom from servility to a particular tradition and dogma. It is right if one has entered into the tradition—whether it is Biblical or Vedic and understood and appropriated the truth it contains. But that is lacking. Often one adopts Advaita because Sankara taught it and one hails Realism because Saint Aquinas advocated it. But have we no duty to

understand and rationally assimilate what Sankara and Aquinas said and ought we not to reject whatever refuses to be rationally assimilated? Intellectual integrity, I am sure, must have a place everywhere, including religion. In Swami Omkar I find this.

Many in India and overseas know Swami Omkar. He has extensively travelled in Europe and America. His Ashramas at Totapalli (East Godavari) and Waltair (Visakhapatnam) are famous. For over three decades his Ashrama has toiled for the spread of the concepts of Human brotherhood and Peace among all nations. Through talks and writings, through pamphlets and journals he has done this. Some branches of his Ashram have been opened on the other side of the Atlantic and also in the land of Geothe and Hegel. All this is good but the results are not spectacular. That is as it must be; for the labourers are few and the vineyard is so unwieldy and weedy.

For the last two years Swami Omkar has been silent and he intends to be so. He finds a strength and a new spiritual upsurge in silence. But he has not become an anchorite. He is interested in the world, its problems and their solution. He is helping the world in his own way probably the right way. Santi Ashram is running a very enlightening journal PEACE and it has recently started another venture—-'Peace' Institute of Indic Studies.

And now about this book: I must say I find it wonderful. Made up of one hundred and eight chapters, it presents to us as many meditations. It is something like Pascal's 'Pensees'. No doubt we miss that splendid literary elegance and also that razor-edged keenness of the great Frenchman. But can that Jansenist Catholic thinker claim as much width and as much real catholicity as Sri Swami Omkar shows in this brief but memorable book?

I aver that the following pages are full of sustaining inspiration and deep meaning.

May you express PEACE in thought, word and deed, and thus help to vibrate IT, from heart to heart, in the community, nation, and the world at large, until PEACE pervades and permeates the whole universe, through your IDEAL LIFE OF PEACE!

This is the prayer of your brother OMKAR.

OM! OM! OM!

1. INHALE AND EXHALE PEACE

Peace is our Birthright, The Soul is Peace, SANTOYAM ATMA-Eternal Bliss.

Born in the sanctum of heart Your life can be full of peace, Full of glory and poise, On your forehead God's kiss.

God's kiss on your front, No trouble now and here, Your world—a lake of peace Waveless and clear.

Peace is the birthright of every Soul, nay, the Soul is Peace. *Santhoyam Atma*, says the Upanishad. He who practises this Mantram, would realise God not in the remote future, but here and now. With every inhalation of yours try to take in Peace and try to give out Peace only with every exhalation. Your very life should become Peace. He who feels this Peace, that is all-pervasive, experiences it not only in the innermost sanctum of his heart, and to the very marrow of his bones, but everywhere outside too. For him the whole world becomes one vast undisturbed Lake of Peace. The troubles and conflicts, the misery and exploitation, the sin and shortcomings that are apparent everywhere, cease to exist for him. Eternal poise and everlasting stability are his. He who thus realises Peace realises God, for verily, the two are one.

2. RELIGION AND LIFE ARE ONE

God is one. He is without a second.

Worship of God is high religious life.

For He is all-in-all, eternal truth.

Blessed is he, who lives in Him

—there is no strife.

God is one. He is without a second—Ekameva Advitiyam. He is the All. Religion is the worship of God, the worship of All. As such, religion and life are not two but one. For the sage, religion is life and life is religion. To live integrally is to live religiously. God is Love, and hence to live religiously is to live as Love. Blessed is the soul, that has realised this Truth.

3.EXISTENCE, KNOWLEDGE AND BLISS ABSOLUTE

Merge in the ocean, in the Absolute. Forget yourself. For you are nothing—and yet all, Brahman Itself.

The Absolute, Brahman, is the ocean. Vast, deep and fathomless it is. Creation is the wave. The individuals are the bubbles. In the ocean there is nothing but existence, wisdom and bliss. When the bubble bursts, it merges with this ocean of *Sat-chit-ananda*. Unlimited bliss and infinite awareness are its possession, nay it becomes THAT.

And what then is the possession, and who is the possessor? This is to be experienced in silence. Inadequate are words to express it. But this experience does not become complete till it is achieved both in contemplation and work.

For, the Brahman is the invisible as well as the visible, the unmanifested as we as the manifested, yet it transcends both.

4. DELUSION OF THE SNAKE AND THE ROPE

God is real, existing alone, The rest is Maya. Why run after delusion? Let it be gone! Your birthright is Ananda.

The Real and the unreal never both existed. They do not and will not coexist. There was only one at the beginning, the True. And the true it is that exists and will exist "Sat eva Soumya idam agra asith". The not-true never existed, does not exist, and cannot exist in the future also. God alone exists, nothing else exists outside or apart from Him.

Art thou God or nothing? Thou art God, for nothing else exists. Enough of the illusion and running after the mirage. Recognize either the rope or the snake. Together both of them cannot abide. Enough unto the day of the snake-idea. Thou hast suffered enough on account of it. Realise now the rope, the one Reality, God.

5. ALL IS GOD

All is God, the Cosmic Source

In East and West.

Why always struggle? Surrender yourself.

In God is rest.

God is the All. Wherever you turn your eyes to the east, south, west or north, it is God whom you behold. Above, below,on every side it is the Divine that envelops you. *Brahma eva idam amrtam prastath, Brahma paschat, Brahma dakshinatacha uttarascha*. It is from the 'Divine' that wisdom, as well as ignorance originate. Then why this struggle? Why these prayers and meditations, these fasts and mutterings of the Mantra? The Strugle too is an illusion. For who forsooth, is the struggler, and with whom, and for what, is he struggling? Give up, therefore, all struggles. Surrender yourself to the Infinite and abide in Silence.

6. SUNDAY, THE DAY OF SUNSHINE

Sunday—the day of the Sun!

Let the Sun of the Soul too shine bright.

Let the clouds be always dispelled.

Be established forever in light!

Today is Sunday, the day of the Sun of Light, resplendent. I am always happy on Sunday, for it is the day of rest and relaxation. It is the day on which worldly affairs are put aside.

But why have Sunday once a week only? Why not let every day be a Sunday, a day of light, prayer and peace, a day of rest and relaxation? Let the Sun of the Soul shine forth, let the clouds that veil the Sun, be dispelled. "*Tatvam pushan apravrunu satyadharmaya dhristaye*". May we be established and centred in the Sun forever!

7. FREEDOM FROM FOREIGN MATTER

Let your mind stand still and be calm,

All desire is vanished and gone,

Suturated with Truth,

Freedom you have won.

It is days since I took food or water. I feel weak but at the same time I feel free and light. Really, contemplation is possible only when the mind runs not after this and that affair, and the body craves not for food and raiment. When the mind stands still, undisturbed and calm, it is saturated with Truth. Yogah chittavritti nirodhah. No prayer or meditation is necessary. No effort is needed. Sit thou still calm and pure. It is to the pure and the childlike that Heaven belongs.

8. CHARGE YOUR BATTERY WITH GOD-HOOD

Open your eyes and see

Light and Eternal Love!

Open your eyes and feel

Eternal Bliss from above!

Man is like a battery. If he is aware of God, the battery is charged; if not, like the discharged battery, he is lifeless. But the metaphor is not capable of complete application. While the battery requires the power to charge it from outside, the power that is to animate man is within himself. All that he has to do, is to become aware of his eternal possession. He should only open his eyes and see that he is ever full of light, life and love.

9. COSMIC CONSCIOUSNESS

Happiness lies in yourself
So stay in this God-like state,
Where the finite becomes Infinite!
Fling open the cosmic gate!

Beatitude or salvation is the cessation of all struggle, strife and conflict. In that state, the finite becomes the Infinite. But this state is not something to be acquired anew now. It is something which is possessed by every soul eternally. Only the soul has forgotten its pristine glory and lives in an illusion, like the man who has forgotten that the watch is on his wrist, and searches for it in every other place, and is sad because he finds it not, the soul searches for happiness everywhere, forgetting that all happiness lies in itself.

10. LET THE SUN OF SUNS DISPEL THE CLOUDS

As the Sun will rise after dawn,
Let the Sun of your soul arise,
Dispelling all the dark clouds,
Let the sun of the suns make you wise.

It is dawn now. Darkness has not as yet vanished completely. The Sun has not yet risen. But he shall arise. There are signs of his advent. The "ushas" heralds him.

Let the Sun of your Soul also arise. Let Him dispel all the dark clouds of ignorance and egoism. May He shine in His glory parching up the little ponds of envy, malice, cruelty etc., and may He make the crops of happiness, good-will and sweetness thrive!

11. COME OUT OF THE CAGE OF THE BODY

You are not the body itself;

A cage it is for your Soul

Cling not to the earthly bonds;

The boundless Earth is your goal.

Do you wish to be imprisoned forever in this small and lightless, dungeon of flesh and blood, that is, the body—the physical body? Yearn you not for freedom? Wish you not to soar in the skies of delight, unfettered and free? Then, come out and feel yourself, in tune with the Infinite. How could the finite and earthly give you unlimited happiness? Emerge from the small ego in which you are enmeshed, and acquire Cosmic-consciousness.

Why do you identify yourself with this body, its joys and sorrows? Body-consciousness is the root of all misery. It is bondage. Cling not to this corpse, realise that you are the boundless, the *Brihat* and the virat, *Bhouman*.

12. THE WHOLE WORLD IS IMAGINATION

The Invisible and Eternal is real.

This hold in your thoughts alone.

Don't think of your pain and suffering,

Live in God, and Peace you have won.

Bondage and salvation are imagination of the mind. Where is bondage in the Heights? Where is freedom there? Who has fettered you, that you should think of freeing yourself? Where is the evil, the misery and the suffering, that can trouble you, while all is joy? Worldly cares, ills of the body—say you? Where are they? Are not they chimeras, you have yourself raised? Bondage and freedom, evil and good, body and world—imagination these are all. It is the nature of thought to revel amidst these dualities and opposites. Unreal they are all. That which is beyond thought, that which is the Source of all things, is the Real. It is You. It is the Inner Self, Changeless, Invisible and Eternal. May you realise your Essence and be established in THAT!

13. THE RICHEST TREASURE—MYSEL F

The Inner Self is my richest treasure.

I cannot lose it; it is my soul.

The Inner Self is the Highest treasure,

To find it, to keep it--my only goal

I am fortunate, for I have found the richest treasure. My treasure consists not in lands or buildings, in pounds or in any articles. My treasure lies in myself. I have found my Soul, in that I have acquired everything. The Self is the richest treasure in heaven or earth. Everything is desired for the sake of the Self—*Atmanastu Kamaya*. Self comes first, and last, and final. Having found It, verily have I found everything.

14. YOU ARE ETERNALLY IN GOD

Can you forget God?

You live and breathe in Him.

Eternally you are in God.

He is your light within.

Have you forgotten God? Nay, it is impossible. How can you forget Him? You live and breathe in Him. You work and think in Him. For indeed there is not anything in heaven, earth or hell that is not God! Forgetfulness of God! It is a contradiction. Whatever you think, do or say, is of God and in God. So make not an effort to remember Him. Give up all effort and struggle. Do as you please or think whatever you please. Or sit still and do not think of anything. It is all one and the same, for you are eternally in God, as One without a second.

15. VITALITY OF THREE KINDS

Be active as much as you can.

In Vitality centered in Peace,

Serene and immersed in it,

You 'll win divinest bliss.

From every side you are asked to be not idle, to be doing something, to be active. You have to be active, vital. Yes, but what sort of activity, what kind of vitality? Is it the ever bustling activity of the modern industrial age, or is it the slow but startling vitality of the panther or the cave-man? Neither; for the one is *rajasic* and the other *tamasic*. It is activity founded on calm, vitality centred in Peace, that you should cultivate. "Karmani akarma-yah pasyeth, akarmanicha karma-yah". Serene and immersed in inner Peace, you should ever be. Active you should be also, but not for the sake of the ego. For the Divine and in the Divine should you be active. From there should your vitality be derived.

16. SELF IS WITNESS OF ALL

Your thoughts are not your own, Neither work, nor sleep, nor dream,

Self is witness of all.

Abandon yourself to Him.

When you do a thing, think you that you do it? When you think a thought, believe you that you are its author? When asleep you are, is it you that sleep? No. It is He, that is the Author of all action, that is the Master of all works (Karmadyaksha). Without Him the breeze stirs not, the fire crackles not, nor does the sun shine. "Thasya bhasaa sarvamidam vibhathi." When you are thinking, it is He that thinks, when you are doing, it is He that does. Meditate on Him and merge in Him. Yet, He is beyond speech and thought. What should one do then? Nothing. Abandon yourself utterly to Him, "Ekam saranam vraja".

17. THOUGHTS ARE THE RAYS OF THE SUN OF SUNS

The waves remain with the Ocean,

The rays are not separate from the Sun,

And thoughts are the rays of Divinity

Pasya me yogam aisvaram.

The Sun sheds his rays of light, everywhere—on all sides. But where do they go, when he disappears? Do not they go with him? The ocean ceaselessly sends forth waves. Yet, is one single wave separated from the ocean and lost? No. The waves remain with the ocean, yet they are sent out. So too thoughts and deeds emanate from the Soul. But not one thought or deed is separate and aloof from the Soul. Their locus standi is the Soul. They are always in it. Yet they are not the Soul, just as the rays are not the sun, and the waves are not the ocean. The Soul is unmanifested and manifested. Yet it is neither. It transcends both. 'pasya me yogam aisvaram".

18. NO FORGETFULNESS IN GOD

Can I forget my God, my Soul?

Can I forget Him, my life?

Being in the chamber of my own Heart,

He is my help in each strife.

Can I forget God, who is the life of my life, and the Soul of my Soul? But I am forgetting Him. Yet am I not remembering Him even in my forgetfulness? Does not He sit like the unbidden guest in the chamber if my soul, whether I attend to Him or not? He is with me and in me always, whether I consciously remember the fact or not. Let me, therefore, cast aside the very idea that I could forget Him.

19. INDIVIDUAL SAMADHI IS SELFISH

If you retire to meditate,

Don't drink the cup of samadhi alone,

Let your salvation be a blessing for all.

Give from it, what you have won.

Do you wish to become a recluse in order to become a contemplative, enjoying bliss? Is it for you only that he joys of Samadhi are reserved? Yearn you not to take with you the millions of your sisters and brothers, who are in the dark? Would you feed on the Divine, when others are starving and parching for the lifegiving nourishment? Let your salvation be for the welfare of all, let your Samadhi be for the good of everybody.

20. BREATH IS THE STRING OF LIFE

We all are beads, tied up to a string,

Countless we are, but the garland is one.

The string of life-—it is our breath.

So one we are and never alone.

The Individual is a bead. Countless are the beads. But the string that ties them up into a garland, is one on the infinite, is strung this garland of finite beings "Sutre mani gana eva". Engross not yourself with the beads, remember also the string, which sustains them all. Fix your attention on it.

21. NOTHING CAN BE ADDED TO OR TAKEN FROM COMPLETENESS

There is nothing for which I should anyhow crave

If I feel complete in a perfect way.

Nothing can be added to or taken from it.

Completeness is perfect eternally.

There are moments when I feel complete in a perfect way. The present moment is one such. I do not wish to close my eyes and meditate, for what have I to gain thereby? Neither do, I wish to open my eyes and gaze at the outer beauty. For how do I profit from it? Everything is complete and perfect. There is nothing for which I should crave, there is nothing that I should work for, for I have been always complete.

Suppose I do not recognise this perfection, this completeness, and remain silent. Do I lose anything? Nothing whatsoever. Does the rock lose its rockiness, if it toils not? Does the rose forego its sweet beauty, if it works not? Nothing can be added to, or subtracted from, perfection by our exertions. Purnamadhah Purnamidham, Purnaath Purnamudhachayate; Purnasya Purnamadhaya Purnam eva avaishyate. Realise that you are perfect and complete eternally. After that you may do or stop doing anything.

22. HOLY BREATH DESTROYS THE EGO

The ego is the root of lust, of passion and greed,
Destroy it with stalk, with branch and with root,
Inhaling, exhaling the breath divine,
And divine you are, a spark of God.

The ego is at the root of all troubles. From it comes lust, passion, greed and anger. So long as the ego remains, the individual (jiva) has no peace. Only when the ego is annihilated root, stalk and branch, can there be peace.

How to destroy this ego? Identify yourself with the Infinite, the Divine. Realise that you are That. "Soham" with every breath you take in, and every breath you exhale, concentrate on this truth of "Soham" or "That I am". The "Soham" will annihilate all that is restless, fickle and changing.

23. CERTAIN THINGS YOU HAVE TO DO YOURSELF

Hear on your innermost being,

Don't hear on the things of outside,

Let your own soul be glorious,

Overflow of your own light.

My writing table is clustered with all kinds of junk. All sorts of books and dictionaries, pens and papers crowd it. But can I rely on these books to write something? If I rely on them, it will be the writing of the authors of these books, and not mine. How will it be my writing, my message? If you have something to express, express it straight from your innermost being. Whatever you do think or say, let it be a spontaneous out flowing of your soul. Rely not on the things of outside. Whatever Plato thought and said, whatever Kant thought and said, whatever Vyasa or Valmiki wrote, is contained within you also. Dam it not, allow your Soul to flow, and wash away all dirt and sins.

24. THE ONE UNIVERSAL ENERGY

There is one Energy working in all
Working in the Sun, in the sea,
Be aware of its Presence, its changeless form,
It is working in you and in me.

The sources of energy may seem many, the Sun the water-falls, the sea, electricity etc. But ultimately there is only one Energy in all of them. It is the same energy as is in the Niagara and in the sea. It is the very same Energy, as is in me, and is now making me think and write. Nothing is done without its support and sanction.

When you are thinking and scheming, it is THAT which is thinking and scheming in you. So there is nothing to worry about, or be sorry for. Only be aware of the Presence in silence and activity, in the ebb and flow, in joy and pain, in health and sickness. When you cognise the Changeless in change, you will be blessed with Peace and Cosmic Joy.

25. THE SOUL IS ABOVE THOUGHT

Being thinking, being praying,

It is God, working through you.

As the waves are the ocean, arising or calm,

So your soul is God, living in you.

Are you sorry, that you do not find time to pray and meditate? Are you worried, that you have to think out so much, and do so many things? What is it, that does or think, when you do or think of something? Is it not God that is working through you? In what way do you become less by thinking and doing, and more, by not thinking and not doing? Whether the waves rise a hundred feet high, or do not rise at all, it is still the ocean. Similarly whether you are praying in the church, or working in the office, it is God who works, in and through, you always.

26. A THOUSAND MILE JOURNEY STARTS WITH THE FIRST STEP

Everything starts with the first step ahead,

Whatever we need, we'll have it in time.

The treasures of God, be on all sides,

Rely on Him, trust in Him, trust the Divine.

Even a thousand-mile journey starts with the first step. Today I have accidentally come in possession of a single Dollar Bill. I feel so rich. Even a million dollars begin with one Dollar. And that I have now. If I use what I have, what I have will grow. Everything else I need, will be added unto it, in its own good time. Talents are not to be buried but to be used.

Divine plenty surrounds all of us. Untold treasures of God lie on all sides of us. We have only to trust and believe in the Divine Providence. Whatever we need, will be vouchsafed to us at the proper time. May we learn to rely on the Divine!

27. AT LAST SAHAJA SAMADHI, GOD CONSCIOUSNESS

Let we merge in **Samadhi**, in this blessed state, In God-consciousness, where all struggles fade, In God-vision, that neither comes nor goes, Eternally present, where bliss and peace rule.

At last 'sahaja Samadhi' or the state of God vision. It may not be permanent. Why not? But can it be only temporary or transitory? Is it not a blessed state which neither comes nor goes, is eternally present?

In Samadhi, all strife and struggle cease. One is free from all prayer and meditation, mind-control and fasts. All duties disappear. Things done are done and finished. Things to be done, do not appear, One feels free, light and irresponsible like a dry leaf. One becomes aloof and detached from all things, like the dry coconut, in which the shell has become separate from the kernel.

28. THE ATMAN IS THE OCEAN

Myself is the Atman, myself is the ocean,

Myself if a drop, a wave all in motion.

I never am separate, being part of the whole,

The Cosmos is throbbing in my heart, in my soul.

My-self or Atman is the ocean. In this ocean of reality, that is perfection, this world is a mere wave, and the organism, a mere drop in the wave. The ordinary man, when he is thinking or acting, thinks that this body, this drop, is acting. But for the God-man, the drop is only a component in the wave and the wave only a part of the ocean. Every drop, however tiny it may be, is it separate from the ocean, that is the whole?

In every beat of his heart, the wise man recognises the cosmic throbbing, in every action and thought of his, he sees the Universal Action.

29. THE INDIVISIBLE BREATH

In whatever we do, it is the Spirit in all,

In the Universe, in me and in you the same call,

The Source of all breath, all sound, speech and sight

Is the Infinite, Tat twam asi – eternal Light.

Is it the eye that sees, when I see? Is it the ear that hears, When I hear? And is it the tongue that tastes, when I eat? It is the Spirit, the very same Spirit that is in me, is in you and the universe, that sees, hears and tastes. Be conscious of this universal witness, the Indivisible Breath, in every action of yours and in your inaction too. Forget the little "I" and the "My". Remember constantly the Source of all breath, speech, sight, touch and sound. In whatever we do, it is the Infinite, that is expressing itself. It is That, which is fulfilling Itself in, and through, this world of things.

30. OUT OF THE DEPTHS FRESH STRENGTH

Of the depths fresh strength, of the dark new light

As tests are in life, so are clouds in the sky.

Through struggles and sorrows we are on the way;

Don't mind thorns, fix your gaze on the aim.

Inspiring is the thought contained in these wise words of Abraham Lincoln.

So long as we are in the body, there is some trouble or the other. That is inevitable. Show me the sky without its clouds, and the rose, without its thorns. Similarly, there is no life without its tests and tribulations. Life is a process of silent, slow and steady growth towards the Goal, through struggles and sorrows. Mind not the thorns and pebbles, the pitfalls and the snares on the way. Have your gaze fixed, your attention rivetted on the Goal. Remember that no amount of obstacles can prevent you from reaching the Goal. If you are determined about it, it is destined for you.

31. EGOISM

Root out the ego, it is like the seeds,

Dormant in the earth, sprouting out when rain greets,

Root out it utterly, looking at your own faults;

To see faults in others—you are not called.

To root out the ego is a difficult task. Often it looks as though it is absent. But when the test comes, out it emerges, like those seeds, which lie dormant through out the summer under the earth, but sprout out, as soon as the rains come.

The ego covers up our own faults, goes afinding faults in others. It forgets the beams in its own eyes, but sees motes in others' eyes. If you want real Peace, utterly abandon the ego.

32. ALL THE WORLD IS BRAHMAN

All the world is God, be aware of Him,

Who is in all, in the holy and the sin,

In the fallen and the risen, in the living and the dead,

Be aware of Him—that is the highest state.

All this *is Brahman*. All the world is God. Everything we see, is part of His manifestation. The Peace that passeth all understanding, belongs only to those rare souls, for whom every one and everything appears as a manifestation of the One God.

It is rather difficult to be aware of God in the ugly, in the sinful, in the ghastly and cruel. Yet, God is as much in it, as in the beautiful, the noble and the holy. To be aware of the one God in the fallen and the risen, the dead and the living, in the crucifixion, as well as in resurrection, is the highest state.

33. YOU ARE THE INTELLIGENCE

You are not the body, be happy and free.

Be a witness in life, all comes through Prakriti.

Don't care for the world, whether darkness or light,

Whether health or illness; Eternal witness your guide.

It has been my habit for years to wake up at dawn and begin the day with the reading of *Ashtavakra Gita*. It was yesterday morning that I read this verse, "You are not the body, neither is the body yours. You are consciousness, the Eternal Witness. Hence be free and happy."

What a wonderful thought that is! But how difficult it is to follow it! Whether it be sorrow or happiness, whether it be prosperity or adversity, whether it be health or illness, *Ashtavakra* asks us to stand aloof and look upon them as only a witness. What should happen, will happen due to *Prakriti*. What have I, the Eternal Seer, the Witness, to do with it?

Today I did not read *Astavakra Gita*. Why should I read it any more? In the above verse is contained the whole truth. Enough if we practise this truth.

34. AMIDST THE CLOUDS OR STUMBLING BLOCKS

As shadows of sorrow are the clouds on the sun,
Don't trouble yourself, if you are standing alone.
The darkest clouds, they will pass, will melt away.
They'll disappear before Sun's mighty ray.

Are you unhappy? Have your trust and love been misplaced, have your kindness and hospitality been misused, have false accusations and calumny been raised against you? Sorrow not. When all is well everyone can be cheerful and contented. He alone is brave who stands towering amidst misery and gloom.

You are the Self, the effulgent Sun. You are not this corpse, this body. Troubles and sorrows may cast their shadows upon you, as do clouds upon the Sun. But the darkest clouds will pass, they will melt away and disappear, before the resplendent glory of the sun.

35. BE SWEET

Never cease shedding love, though you are hurt,

Live in the Atman in deed and in word.

Be like the rose, smelling so sweet,

Though trampled and crushed – sow out love's seed.

Repent not having done good. You may be hurt, kicked and crushed under iron heels mercilessly. Still continue doing good. Blessed are they that are persecuted and fallen, for, they shall be raised and exalted.

Let the arrogant, the haughty, the ignorant and the wicked hurt, wound and crush ruthlessly. But cease not shedding love, life and light towards them. Be like the rose that gives out sweet fragrance, though trampled. Remember that. Let no one repent doing good!

36. THE PRESENT MOMENT

Waste not the moment, the presence is your power,

Waste it not, use it, utilise each hour.

Don't look to the future, don't think of the past.

In tune with the Infinite be peaceful at last.

Waste not the present moment. In it consists your supreme wealth. The present is your highest moment. As such, waste it not, treasure it up, hug it. But how can you utilise it to the utmost? You can make the fullest use of it by attuning yourself with the Infinite, by abandoning yourself to the Divine, this moment.

37. LOVE IS THE UNFAILING REMEDY

God is shining everywhere in unceasing love,

God is shining from each face with light from above.

Surrender to Him, see His sweet loving face,

Surrender to Him in love's shining rays.

I have the vision, yea, I have it. After passing through the terrible Gethsemane of excruciating mental struggle, agony and suffering, I am glad to say that I have won, and that I have the Vision.

I give up now all struggle and strain. I have nothing now to achieve, nothing to long for. I surrender myself to Love, Universal Love. No more is any one an enemy or evildoer to me. All are the living images of God. All is love, abundance and forgiveness now. No more are resentment and self-defence; no more any of those self-righteous arguments. Every where I see the face of the Deity, for, all is God.

God is shining from every face!

38. IMPOSSIBLE TO FORGET GOD

I'm living in God, for He is my life,
In trials, in tests, in sickness, in strife,
In sleep and in dream, never absent from Him,
In Samadhi saturated—His glory I sing!

How can I be away from God, when whatever I think or do, is of Him! If I am quiet, it is He. If I am bustling and hustling, it is He. If I am healthy, it is He. Even in sickness it is He. In all tests, trials and tribulations it is He. Where, then, is the moment, when He is away, aloof or absent from me? In sleep, in wakefulness and in dream it is He. And it is He again in *Samadhi*.

How glorious! Every sound expresses Him. Every sight portrays Him. Every manifestation springs from Him. I am privileged to be saturated and surrounded by His glory.

39. THE LOWER AND THE HIGHER SELF

Two natures in you are living, lower and higher self.

They are fighting and struggling, ineffable their strength.

Will you go to perdition? Or take the right way?

The last leads to Heaven, see you the holy ray?

Man is bipolar. In him there are two natures—the lower and the higher, the animal and the divine. The two are incessantly fighting to win over man. The lower nature tries to drag man to the life of senses, to perdition. The higher nature longs to lead man towards the life of Reason, to Heaven, Wisdom consists in giving one's assent to the higher nature and co-operating with it.

40. THE PRESENCE IS ABOVE FORGETFULNESS

Why do we not feel God's Presence always,

Though longing for it each moment, all days?

Remember, His Presence is always there.

Don't worry, for ever you are in His care.

Sometimes one feels the presence of God, sometimes not. What is wrong? Why does not one feel the Presence always, in each and every moment?

This feeling or not feeling is all the imagination of the restless mind. The awareness of the Presence is beyond remembrance and forgetfulness. The presence is always there. It is the one supreme fact. There is no second thing. So you cannot forget IT and remember something else. No one need, therefore worry about not remembering God's Presence.

41. LET THE CENTRE BE WITHIN

Be established in Self, be centred in Him,

Hold fast to the Self in thick and in thin.

Don't depend on the world, don't depend on a friend.

The Centre within is your holy land.

You may have mastered the principles of all religions and philosophies, still you cannot avoid having moments of depression, heaviness and sorrow. That is so because your perceptions and conceptions are not centred in the Self. Unconsciously at least, the centre is for the time being, placed outside. It is shifted from within to without, hence all this helplessness, agony and suffering.

If you want to be perpetually happy, there is but one way to follow. Be established in the Self, be centred in the Self. Through thick and thin hold fast to the Self. The outside thing that attracts you, may be a big and mighty person or thing, but depend not on it. Unruffled peace belongs only to those, who are centered in the SELF.

42. THE CAUSE IS WITHIN

Be a Sun, radiating everywhere your clear light;
Spread your happiness, cheerfulness far and wide.
Make the best and the highest with God-like thought;
In yourself is the cause, your luck and your fault.

If you are happy and cheerful, you will radiate happiness and cheerfulness around you, as the Sun does the light. If you are sorrowful and miserable, like the noxious weed, which scatters its foul smell all around, you will spread your sorrow and misery.

But it is a comfort and consolation to know that your joy and sorrow are not wrought by outside factors. You are the sole and sufficient cause of your happiness and unhappiness, your health and sickness. You need not invoke any outside power or deity. All that you have to do, is to realise that you, the Self, are beyond dualities and thought, and all things are nothing but an expression for your will (ichcha). As such, you can change all your negative thought into positive, and assert only the Best and the Highest, under all conditions.

43. BE NATURAL

Don't torture your self, don't carry a cross.

God us within you, He is all your force.

You'll find Him in silence, you'll find Him in sound.

With Him you're eternally united and sound.

I have been guilty now and then, of torturing myself with difficult austerities. I have mercilessly injured my body at times, innumerable crosses have I carried. But is all this necessary? When God is within as well as without, pervading and permeating through all my countless cells, why should I torture myself with restless practices? If the state of *Samadhi* or trance, occurs to me naturally, it is all right. But why on earth should I force it on myself? Is not God as much in wakefulness, as in trance? If I cannot find Him in Silence, in Sound I shall find Him.

If I fail to express His glory in meditation, in work I shall express Him. It is in Him and by Him that I walk, talk and write. From Him, then Unmanifested, is all expression and manifestation. Be it work or meditation, one thing is certain. I am inseparably and eternally united with Him.

44. NO MORE FORGETFULNESS

Oh God, have I lost you? I'm helpless and sad!

For if I forget you, I cannot be glad.

No, no, you are penetrating my heart and my soul,

Your light is within me, above and below.

The least forgetfulness of God or the Light within, even if it is for a millionth fraction of a second, makes me miserable, helpless and sad. But what is forgetfulness? Do not memory and forgetfulness come from Him? The Light of lights is eternally present, penetrating to the very core of my being, and pervading through the whole universe.

It is not possible to forget God and remember something else. For, what is that, which is not He? That He could be forgotten, is only an illusive thought.

Behold, the all-present Light is here, there, within without, above, below, and on all sides. Which ever way you turn, you are under its illuminating rays. Never can you be in the dark. Recognize this and be silent once for all. Delude not yourself with the illusive thought of forgetfulness.

45. IN THE WORLD OF GOD-CONSCIOUSNESS

Be always in me, let me live in Your Light,
In Your all-pervasive Presence, in Your world so
And now You are here and filling my heart, bright'
God-consciousness is my eternal part.

I cannot wait for God to come to me later on. Unbearable to me is the thought, that God is not now with me, and that He will come to me in the uncertain future. I need not even meditate to attain God. If God is not already in and around me, whence does He come?

He is here and everywhere, He is eternally one with me. All that I have to do is only to be aware of His all-pervasive presence. Even if I am not in His presence consciously, yet I am and have been always in Him.

46. GOD-REALIZATION NOW AND HERE

God-realization now and here,

You never need search Him, His voice you can hear.

Now open your eyes and feel Ananda.

He is eternally realized, NITYA SIDDHA.

God-realization now and here. Now and here? Is it not full and complete eternally? Have spatial and temporal modes of speaking any reference to this supreme and eternal fact? Was there a time when God was non-existent, and will there be ever such? I have been, am, and will always abide in perfection in God's Presence. He is eternally realized, nitya siddha.

There is no need to shut your eyes to search for Him within. Open your eyes, for, He is here. You need not wait for Him, for, He has been eternally in quest of you.

47. RELIGION IS REALIZATION OF CHEERFULNESS

Religion is realization, cheerful hilarity.

Let your soul be smiling, singing His beauty.

Come face to face with God, expressing the Divine,

He is Anando Brahma, infinite-sublime!

Aflame is my Soul, bubbling I am with laughter. Yes, why not? Religion is realization. Realization is laughter. Religion does not mean remaining with a long, sad and mournful face, muttering to yourself something within.

Religion means coming face to face with God, that is within and without. To express the Divine in this world of tests and trials, is religion.

Anando Brahma. Bliss is God. He is there, where the little self, the ego, has been rooted out, Egoism creates pride, passion and arrogance. Identification of the finite with the Infinite kills pride, passion and arrogance, and creates rippling Laughter in the Heart, and Peace of the Soul.

48. THE RESTLESS CHILD

In a trance of ecstasy I enjoyed highest Bliss,

Feeling in silence, in meditation, God's kiss.

But like a restless child, descending from the height,

I want to share with you the rapturous light.

A little child, playful and restless, am I. The child sows a seed, and no sooner has he covered it with earth, than he digs it up, to see whether it has germinated. I close my eyes to contemplate and enjoy the Bliss Absolute in a trance of divine ecstasy. But no sooner do I begin feeding on the Divine, than I descend from the heights and begin to write, toying with inadequate words.

I long to bring within your reach, all the fruit that I have begun to taste. I myself never wait until I finish eating the fruit in full. But what am I to do? Helpless I am in subduing my burning desire to share to share with you all my experiences. It is sweet doubt to sit all day long, in silent contemplation and rapturous ecstasy. But I evade it. May I be of some use to many a weary and aspiring soul!

49. BEHOLD, THE ONE IN THE MANY

May God is everywhere, within and without;

He is in my heart, He is in my thought.

I see Him in others and in the whole world.

He is beyond my senses, speaking in each word.

I close my eyes to see Him. Again I open them to find Him; for, is not He within and without too? Within. He is in the depths of heart, the marrow of the bone and the cores of the cells. Without, He is in every form and name.

But who is it that sees through these eyes? Who else can it be, other than He, for, there exists only He, without a second. He it is that sees. He it is that is seen. He who sees the one in the many, is blessed. But he who sees without seeing is privileged; for, He is beyond sight, sound, smell, touch and taste.

50. THE MIND CAN MAKE AND UNMAKE

In the beginning there was Void, creating Life and Mind, Mind created good and evil in mankind.

Now never be restless, seek the one great Source;

Merge into Prana, into Void—the highest force.

IN THE BEGINNING THERE WAS VOID. From it emerged Life and from it arose Mind.

The Mind is like a mischievous and intoxicated monkey. It is ever restless. But it has great power. It can make and unmake. It is the mind that makes one a sinner and another a saint. Be aware of it. Let it not be restless. Let it seek its Source, Life, or *Prana*, and merge itself therein. And let the *prana* seek its origin and be in its turn, assimilated with the great Void. Then only can the Peace that passeth all understanding, be ushered in.

51. THE VISION OF COMPLETENESS

In the Vision of completeness, overflowing with His bliss

I'm complete, I'm perfect, in effulgent peace,

Radiant in happiness, full of serenity—

Na thasya karyam karanam cha vidyathe.

I have had the Vision. Times without number have I had it. In it I see everything as complete and perfect. There are no duties to be performed by me, and those that have been performed, are performed and finished for ever.

I am bubbling with laughter because of completeness. I am overflowing with happiness. So, I see nothing else but to laugh and laugh.

It is a Vision of Perfection, of Completeness. There is nothing to be taken away from it, nothing to be added unto it. Once we possess this Vision there is nothing more to be done or undone. "Na thasya karyam karanam cha vidyathe."

52. WHY DON'T YOU LAUGH WHEN TROUBLES COME?

Why don't you laugh, when troubles come?

In trials, in tests, you never must moan.

There is but one sorrow, one trouble for the soul,

To lose God. The Real State—your only Goal!

The other day I receive a blackmailing letter cavilling at me and the Ashram work. Shall I moan over it? Shall I be depressed and cast down? Can the Sun of my Soul be affected by the passing clouds of praise and calumny? In His own unique splendour and glory He shines, clouds or no clouds.

This is now the proper time for me to laugh. When troubles and tribulations come, when tests and trials come, then is the time to laugh. In praises and laudations it is easy to find God. But that finding is not complete unless and until you find God in blame and calumny, in failure and ignominy. Now, therefore, is the time for me to laugh and be happy. After all, there can be only one real sorrow, one trouble for the Soul. And that is, when It forgets Its own nature. So long as it is aware of its own Real State, and is firmly established in Itself, It can laugh at all imaginary troubles.

53. PRAY FOR STRONGER SHOULDERS

Give me, O God, stronger shoulders To bear all burdens with a smile: I'll never groan, I'll never murmur, I'll drink the cup of your choice wine.

I know that I can bear my troubles.

Know that you will help your son.

And though your ways are quite mysterious,

Thy will, O Lord, it may be done!

The wise man never prays to God for lessening his burdens or removing them. He only prays for a stronger back, so that he may bear all burdens with smiles. The weak and ignorant man, when he is passing through fiery ordeals, cries aloud, "Lord, do I deserve these?" Yes, he deserves them all. They are all intended. Not a straw mover without the Lord's command. All troubles and trials are there to test your fortitude and equanimity. Every new experience is for your own good. Any one can be spiritual, when all is well. The acid test is on, only in the thick of troubles and misery. As such, the wise man never groans or murmurs. To the last he drains the cup that is set before him, by his Lord, whether the cup be of choice wine or deadly poison.

Further the Lord never sends us troubles and sorrows, that cannot be borne by us. He gives us only, what each of us can bear, and He gives them not vengefully, but to put our mattle and enable our soul to grow. Incomprehensible and mysterious are God's ways. Peace belongs to him only, who can say with all his heart, "Not my will, O Lord, may Thine be done!"

54. PEACE IS WITHIN

Do you see Peace in symbols, In temples, in masters, in friends? Don't seek divine Peace outside, For empty will be your heart.

The Peace you long for, is in you, In the stillness of your own heart. Steep in the inner silence,

Peace inside and outside, then you find.

Seekest thou Peace in symbols and shibboleths, in vain and empty things outside? Unprofitable is thy effort then. Peace, infinite peace, cannot be found in finite teachers and masters, in cults and temples, in societies and friends.

The Peace for which you long, is within you, in the stillness of your own purified heart. If you desire it, be still, and give up relving on outside things. Arrest your restless mind and sink into the Silence within. When you are steeped in the inner Peace, when you are soaked in it to the marrow of your bones, you will come to see it not only within, but also without, in the outside things also. Everywhere you will find it then. In fact you will be flooded with it from all sides.

55. FEELING THE PRESENCE

How can I feel His Presence?

I long for it whatever I do.

Now hear: there is only One Power,

Expressing itself in you.

Be aware of the One Great Master,

Living in body and mind,

Think of Him, think of Him always,

And Him forever you'll find.

Strange it may seem, but every time I wash my hands and wipe them with a towel, I feel the interpenetrating Presence intensely. So at times I keep on drying my hands indefinitely. I do not know why I should feel His Presence especially in this motion of my hands. Probably the Freudians would come out with one of their queer explanations. Let them! But what is necessary for me, is to try and feel the same experience in all that I do. For instance I am now writing. What is it, that writes through this hand? What is it, that thinks in my brain? It is the same One and Indivisible Power, that is expressing Itself in all these motions. He is the Master of all motions. Let us be aware of His presence in all motions of the mind as well as in the body, in thoughts and deeds.

56. THE INFINITE IN THE FINITE

Still I am bound to the body.

How long shall I bear this weight?

When its function gets fulfilled,

Then like a dry leaf will it fade?

O Glory, when the soul leaves the body,

In the Omnipresence to merge!

When the jug is forever broken,

The infinite soul gets new birth.

I feel free and complete within. But this feeling is only inner, for, it is still bound to the body, though it be an illusion. The Infinite within the finite, is the idea that expresses my present feeling. Though this is not the highest state, the *Videha Kaivalya*, yet this state gives one peace and poise.

But how long can the Infinite be confined within the finite body? How long can the body bear the weight and immensity of the Infinite? When its function is fulfilled, like a dry leaf the body will drop off without effort. Then will the soul come out of the body and will completely merge within its own Omnipresence, Omnipotence, Omniscience. The ether enclosed within the jug, becomes entirely one with the all- pervading ether if the jug is broken, though it was not different from it even before. These are all mysteries known only to the knowers of the Soul.

57. MOMENTS OF ELEVATION AND DEPRESSION

Don't sigh in moments of darkness, When misery faces you. Even wings of the mystics are tired, When shadows of misery surround them.

But the saints shadows they are That come and pass and fade. As the tortoise withdraws its limbs, In the inner centre, saints wait.

In the inner centres abiding, They wait till danger is past, To soar high into the regions Of rapture, now won at last.

Mystics and saints have soared high into the regions of the formless, in their moments of ecstasy and rapture. But they cannot stay there forever. When their wings are tired, they come down, and they too have their moments of sadness and sorrow. In the face of cruelty, injustice, corruption and misery they too have their sufferings.

Thus in every life there are moments of elevation and inspiration as well as moments of darkness and misery. But there is a difference between the sage and the man of the world. The sage looks at the phenomena of life, perched on the pedestal of his soul-poise and equanimity. When misery and suffering face him, at once he realises them as passing shadows which are not worth any attention. Quickly he withdraws himself into his own inner centre, the nucleus of his Soul, and there he abides untouched by outward influence, like the tortoise, which withdraws all its limbs into its shell in face of danger, sand only comes out, when that danger is past. "Yada samharate chayam kurmonganiva sarvashah."

58. WORK DRIVES AWAY ALL WORRY

Don't worry, dear soul, don't worry,

In reality all is joy.

For God, He gave you a servant,

That nothing may you annoy.

You know the name of this servant,

His noble name is Work

All worry will quickly fade,

That nothing, nothing can hurt.

Why feel sad and worried, my child? What is there to be worried over? What is worry? Where does it come from? If you analyse, it dwindles into nothing, for, at the source all is light and joy.

Do you not remember the powerful saying, "Work kills no one, but worry kills multitudes." When you have grown blue with worry, begin to do some work, for work drives away all worry. After all, God is not yet dead. So long as He is alive, the Light and the Law remain. Why worry? Wake up and bask in the Light and follow the Law.

Worry is a terrible, but only an imaginary vampire. Never give in to this terrible mental malady. Where is this dark cloud of worry in the Sun of suns?

59. HAPPINESS IS IN UNION WITH GOD

This will be my happiest day!

Say so, when greeting the Sun.

Spend it in the Lord's service,

And as His God-like son.

Happiness lies in union

With God, the Indwelling Light.

In work as well as in silence,

Feel God's Presence—your day will be bright

Wake up every day with a firm determination to make it the happiest, and the best day of your life. You can do so. It all lies in the way, you make use of those tiny, but precious moments, which make up the day. Spend them all in the Lord's service and in absorption in Him.

Real happiness does not consist in the possession of many cattle, elephants and horses, automobiles and gold, beautiful damsels and houses. *Bahun pasun hasthi hiranyam asvan...Ramah Sarathah sa turyah*. It lies only in union with God, the indwelling light. As man tries to feel oneness with the Light within and that which is also without, he becomes happy and contented, whether he is working or meditating. To feel God's Presence in both work and silence, moment by moment—that is the way to make this day the best as well as the happiest.

60. THE REAL ADJUSTMENT IS WITHIN

All adjustment must start from within,

From the source of peace in your heart,

Don't think of reforming others,

To adjust yourself be your part!

Man wants to adjust, rearrange, and remake everything in the outside world, but he does not try to adjust himself. Yet the real adjustment, the real orientation should begin with himself, from within. When there is adjustment within, there is adjustment without. When there is Peace within, in the heart, all is Peace without also. Hence all adjustment and arrangement must start from within.

But, alas, the man of the world, when there is something wrong, wants to adjust everything else, except himself. He tries to reform this man and that man, but lo, he has not yet reformed himself! He drops a letter to this man, he puts in a word to that man, trying to smooth things over and adjust them. But he does not go to the Source, and does not adjust himself. If the individual wants Peace, he must first adjust himself reorient himself and this endeavour should begin from within.

61. MAN IS A LION BY NATURE

Man is the living image of God,

By his nature a lion, brave, keen on his road,

But tying with the things of the world of Maya,

He forgets his birthright, forgets Ananda.

Torture him now, again and again,
But the remedy is easy and always at hand:
Renounce false desires, come to your own land.

Misery, agony, suffering and pain

Man, the Living Image of God, is by his very nature, a lion. His birthright is to tear away the veils of ignorance. But, due to wrong association and false imagination, he has forgotten to roar, and has learnt to bleat. He quakes with fear at every turn of the mind. Facts have been reversed. Man, the image of the Highest, has forgotten his intrinsic nature, and has become a fool with the goods of the world.

As a result, man has become subject to misery, agony, suffering, and untold physical and mental pain. If he gives up identifying himself with the body, and renounces his false fears and desires, he will come into his own. He will be then installed in his real status and stature.

62. IMAGINATION, A MERE REED

Sometimes there is in your onward march

A reed of false thoughts, that hinders your Start,

Crush it and trample it under your feet,

Burn it away with the fire of God.

Burn it away with His holy fire,

And burn now away your wrong desire;

Be not a prey to the things of the world,

Recognize the Reality, the Absolute Word.

Will you allow a mere reed, the reed of Wrong and false imagination, to obstruct your onward March? Or will you trample on, and crush this insignificant reed, under your foot, and burn it away in the all-consuming fire of Godconsciousness?

It is high time to assert and express the Highest in you. Do not become a prey to false appearances and wrong imagination. Recognize the Reality, the Absolute and be established in THAT.

63. AFRAID OF SHADOWS

Be rooted in a firm, indestructible rock,

Don't look at the shadows, they are but fog.

Brahman is in you and Thou art That.

Passing storms and onslaughts, like shadows, will fade.

In spite of all religions and philosophies, and in spite of the repetitions of the sacred Vedic texts like "I am *Brahman*", "Thou art That", etc., the learned man is still afraid of shadows of the world—sorrows and fears. Why? Because he has not had a personal experience of Truth, in daily life.

Often it is a philosopher, or a priest, who succumbs to the passing trifle. All this is because he does not stand on a secure foundation. If you are rooted on affirm, deep and rocky foundation, you will withstand the onslaughts of all the passing storms of lust, fear and ignorance.

64. GOOD LUCK

Good Luck! Say so many, good luck indeed!

But my soul's luck itself, what else does it need?

Realizes of God—they have everything,

Having luck in themselves—His praise they sing.

I have on my table a Christmas greeting card, with a picture of a black cat, wishing Good Luck. The cat's eyes are fixed with two glass beads, and for its tail it has some fluffy stuff. Every time I glance at it, I read, "GOOD LUCK". Good Luck, indeed! Is not my Soul itself Good Luck? What other luck or fortune does the Soul need?

The knower's of the Self, the realizer of God, need no Good Luck. They are themselves Good Luck. Their integral experience of the Divine is their Good Luck. In it they have everything.

65. MAKE THE BLESSED MOMENT PERMANENT

There are moments when we feel His presence everywhere,
But when this state fades, you must not despair,
Merge in yourself, see the one Reality,
It's Light is everlasting—in all eternity!

There are moments when I feel the Presence, within, without, everywhere. I feel not only filled and surrounded by it, I feel completely saturated with it.

But this Presence is not something which is transitory and momentary. It is permanent and everlasting, but somehow due to an illusion, man forgets It and becomes desolate. But when there is only one Reality, the Light of lights, and when there is nothing else besides, whence does the illusion come? That is the mystery, the illusiveness of the illusion, the *maya*. But if man merges within himself, and ponders deeply, he will see, that the illusion is not based on anything, that is devoid of any substance, and that in fact, there is no illusion, as ALL IS LIGHT.

66. I CANNOT FORGET MYSELF

I can and I may forget anything,

Myself can't be forgotten, nor can I forget Him.

For God and myself both always are one,

The One without a second as the ray and Suns.

With vividness I have realised another facet of Truth this time. I have had the Vision again. Of what is the Vision this time? It is of the truth, that I cannot forget MY SELF, I can and may forget anything. But how can I forget Myself? And in as much as I remember MY SELF- I remember the Eternal and the Real, for, I am the Real and the Eternal.

That which thinks in me is that very Self. Of course, not all its glory is expressed either in thought or action. But yet, how can I forget It? I can forget those who love me, and those who differ with me; but certainly I cannot forget MY SELF, the One without a second.

67. THE VISION UNIVERSAL

All is God, all is the One Self alone

The whole world is included—a new truth I have won!

The waves of the ocean, they are all the same,

They had but one source and had but one aim.

And all mankind is part of God, the Divine,
They all have a soul, holy, sublime,
I long to embrace all, whether evil or good,
They are countless waves of spiritual floods.

In this new Vision, I have no more any enemies or revilers. I see no tormentors or persecutors. MY SELF—All is God, the One SELF. No one, nothing is excluded from this vision. All are included in it, for the entire world is only a component of it.

I long to embrace all, not only those who love me, but also those who cannot love me, not only those who are good and holy, but also those who are ugly and cruel. For verily, they are all aspects of the Divine. They are the countless waves of one and the same Ocean. Let all the vibrations merge into the one and Indivisible source of all.

68. THE LIGHT IS FREE OF FINITE PLANS

I am the Light, the resplendent Light,
The Eternal, Effulgent and Infinite Light,
Time has vanished, and action will cease,
All homage be to that splendour of Bliss!

Above space, above time, the same Light for ever, It remains as it is, decreases never.

It shines on all, that splendour of Peace.

All homage be to that splendour of Bliss!

I am the Light, the effulgent and resplendent Light. The Eternal and Infinite Light. What are my plans? None. Time vanishes in this **ALL-LIGHT**. Action ceases in this all accomplished Light.

The Light remains as Light, it decreases not, neither does it increase. It shines equally on all, under all conditions. It is the same Light, as is for ever. It is above space, time and causation. All homage be unto that Splendour of splendours, the **ALL-LIGHT**!

69. GOOD FRIDAY — THE SINGING BIRDS

Today is Good Friday, most sacred a day

To all who follow the Lord's holy way.

The birds are singing their joyful song,

And lilies are blooming the way along.

Today is Good Friday, the day most blessed and sacred to all Christians. But who is a Christian? All those who follow the way of the Lord. From early dawn today, the birds have been singing and singing birds of all species, sizes and plumage.

They want me to join them in singing the praises of the Lord. But I cannot this, being the thirty-eight day of my silent Fast. For the next two days, I can only sing within myself. And then, I too shall break into song, as do these birds, praising the Good Lord for all His Blessings.

Easter is associated with Lilies. In the West they call them the Easter Lilies, All through the Ashram, hundreds of lilies are coming out of their sheaths, and are laying bare their hearts, greeting and welcoming the Christ Resurrected.

He's sparkling in your eye and listening in your ear.

Again when he gets a cruel letter, a letter of criticism and condemnation, he begins to worry and waste his precious time and life, not only for days, but for months, thinking over the cruel thrusts and unwarranted and undeserving remarks. A wise man should be above praise and blame. Another helpful way to bear the blame is, when you feel sad, remember all the good that you get, and thus overcome the sorrow with joy, the evil with good. Peace belongs to those, who have risen above duality of every kind.

75. LOVE GOD SELFLESSLY

Don't seek God for help in your troubles only!

He is present with you eternally,

Pervading, permeating the very cells of us all.

There is no separation, here on His cell.

Do you want God for the sake of Love, because He is all Love? Or do you want Him to help you, to smooth over and adjust your troubles in your life? If you want God for the sake of Love or Truth without expecting any reward, behold, He is already within you, pervading and permeating the very cells of your being. He is eternally present with you, from eternity to eternity. There is never a moment of separation between God and yourself.

If you want God for the sake of removing your troubles, or granting boons up, I do not know, where He is. Go to those people who are in trouble, seeking God only because of their troubles. They will direct you to their God, who is far away in Heaven, only to serve them, granting them health, plenty of wealth, and other goods of the world, as well as a long life, in which to enjoy them.

Dear one, if you long to have God, for the sake of love, then come to me. Behold! He is with you, in you, NOW and ALWAYS.

76. ALL COMES FROM WITHIN

The flower comes from the plant and the plant from the seed,

The thought creates the word and the word the deed,

All comes from within, from one same source,

From Creative Silence, the one Great Cause.

"IF YOU DESIRE TO BE ONE WITH GOD, DO NOT COMPLAIN. IF YOU DO COMPLAIN YOU CANNOT BE ONE WITH HIM." Today I came across these wise words uttered in his tests and trials, by a Muslim Saint. This is the last examination in God-identification. If a man puts both his hands round your throat, to choke your life out of you, you are to see only the sweet face of God in him. If a man gives you a fond embrace with one hand, and with the other hand stabs you in the back, you are to feel God's Presence, in the very touch of his hand.

Then alone, will the latent Light in you manifest in all Glory. The saints and sages have done it, in the past. They never complained of their tests and tribulations. They should be thunderbolts of Power and Illumination, but not of destruction and death.

I love to have my thoughts also as flashes of lightning. Indeed, there is power in Silence. How true are the words: Silence is gold and Speech is silver. All great souls, who ever did any good to the world, have been of few words. Let words be thunderbolts of Power. Let thoughts be Lightnings of Peace and Illumination!

81. SELF-RELIANCE

Rely on yourself and on nobody else,

And happy you will ever be.

You are the Eternal and Infinite Self,

Self-reliance makes you free.

Self-reliance and self-radiance, has been the living message of all seers and saints, in both the East and the West. Religion begins with Self-reliance and ends in Self-realization. In one of my Messages in Telugu, written during the fast. I have written that a Lemon tree, which is near the bathroom, is trying to help me, by giving out nearly ten lemons, in this summer season, when lemons are scarce.

Everyday, whenever I see the tree, the question comes- "Did you not exaggerate the number of lemons?" Then, I began to count 1, 2, 3, 4, 5. Perhaps, there are not ten lemons. There may be less lemons. Thus, I keep on counting unconsciously every day. As the tree is full of leaves, the lemons are hidden in the leaves.

Anyway, for the Peace of my Soul, to be more exact and correct, I have changed the number of lemons in the message from ten to five. Thus, one can improve and grow, in little things, as well as in big things.

Hence, where is that best friend? However good and honest your friend may be, he is not expected to know all your faults. How can he know, what you have within? Hence, one who knows your faults, your inner thoughts, is not outside, but he is inside. He is yourself—YOU.

This Peace Prayer, being Universal, satisfies the Dwaithi-the Dualist, Visistadwaiti-the qualified Monist, and the Adwaiti-the Monist. When you begin the Prayer with Tadvanam calling God as *Adorable Presence*, you are a Dualist, When you repeat the life giving words:

THOU WHO ART WITHIN AND WITHOUT, ABOVE AND BELOW AND ALL AROUND", you are a qualified Monist. When you come to repeat the soul-awakening words:

The happy ending of the prayer with the three OM, represents *Omnipresence*, *Omnipotence* and *Omniscience* covering the Past, the Present and the Future, thus establishing Peace and Goodwill, Now and forever on the Rocky Foundation of Personal Experience of Individual Peace, which is bound to be the greatest blessing to the Peace of the world.

In the same Kena Upanishad, we are happy to read the following soul-stirring words which are the essence of the Prayer!

He is the Ear of the ear, the Mind of the mind, the Speech of the speech. He is also the Prana of the Prana, the Eye of the eye. Knowing this, the wise,

having relinquished all false identification of the Self with senses, become Immortal when departed from this world.

Thus the Peace Prayer satisfies every seeker of Truth all over the world. This Peace Prayer need not be confined to the East or the West, for, it is a Prayer coming from within from the heart of every man and woman, of every Religion and Nationality. VARIOUS PARTS OF TOTAPALLI ASHRAM

JNANASHRAM: Two caves to perform intense sadhana in solitude, observing silence after being initiated into sanyasa.

JANAKASHRAM: Facilities are provided to householders who leaving their families want to live like vanaprastha so that they can spend the rest of their lives in prayer, meditation and other spiritual pursuits.

MAITHREYI ASHRAM: A special place provided for woman for sadhana, prayer and meditation.

SWAMI RAMATIRTHA INSTITUTE: A place where spiritual discourses and sadhana camps can be held for the spiritual seekers. There is a museum where Swami Omkar's life and message are pictorially depicted.

SANTI TAPOVANAM: A small hillock near the Siva temple where one can meditate undisturbed for long hours peacefully.

SANTI PEETHAM: A place where all the written volumes of Peace Prayer (likhita Japa) are preserved to spread the potent waves of peace to the entire world.

SUSHILA HOSPITAL: A small hospital where the inmates of the Ashram, guests and the people of the neighboring villages can get medical help.

SPIRITUAL HEALING CENTRE: A spiritual centre where physical as well as psychological problems are cured through prayer, Havan, Japa and paduka puja are performed daily for the well-being of the whole world.

VETERINARY HOSPITAL: Animals of all the neighboring villages get treatment here.

SHANTI SCHOOL: The first Gurukula Vidyalaya was established in 1954 in the Totapalli Hills. In 1981 a High school was inaugurated. 150 boys and girls are being provided free lodging and boarding. The children are imparted with value based education.

OLD AGE HOME: Free meals are provided for the old and destitute irrespective of caste, creed, religion, race and region.

ACCOMMODATION FOR GUESTS: Good food and accommodation are provided for the guests who are single or who are with families, to spend time in peace and prayer.
