

When your eyes are closed, see God within yourself, in the very cells of your being, from the toes to the top of the head.

Thus, God is both within and without, there is never a moment of time either in the past, present or future when God exists not; similarly there is never a speck of space or even an atom, where God exists not.

Thus, He is both within and without, for god is Omnipresent, Omnipotent and Omniscient. Having eyes see you not? Recognize God now and here and be silent, never to forget Him any more, even for the tiniest fraction of a second. Let your eyes see Him, wherever they wander outside, or God is everywhere, let your eyes see Him when they are closed. Thus God is present both in Pravritthi (in the outer world when your eyes are opened), and in Nivritthi (in the inner world when your eyes are closed).
